Alaska Glacier Products, LLC manufactures the Clear Alaskan Glacial brand of fine water in Alaska. We have made the commitment to reducing emissions, energy conservation, and efficient management of transportation and logistics worldwide.

Green Energy Sources

We pride ourselves in coming from one of the purest environments on planet Earth – Alaska. The water collected by Clear Alaskan Glacial is located within four miles of our state-of-the-art bottling plant located right at Eklutna, Alaska. We take great pride in running a completely sustainable operation, which begins with natural hydro-power powered water filtration and processing. Our production and bottling of Clear Alaskan Glacial is managed at high-speed and high-volume efficiency that targets waste in manufacturing and recycling of PET, and other materials.

Efficient Shipping

Clear Alaskan Glacial ships product by utilizing otherwise empty cargo space on vessels already returning to the United States and Pacific – Asia markets. This helps Clear Alaskan Glacial reach consumers while leaving the smallest carbon footprint possible. For those consumers in Alaska, we provide the most efficient water delivery which is fresher by far ... 1400 miles to be exact, from nearest port located in Seattle, Washington

Renewable

Clear Alaskan Glacial works closely with the Alaska Recycling Center to support environmentally safe practices that target waste in the environment and promoting recycling among the State of Alaska, and all customers drinking our products. All bottles are placarded with Conserve and Recycle messaging. Through our membership in the International Bottled Water Association, we work with IBWA to promote PET plastic recycling programs nationwide.

Certiably Sustainable Spring

The beautiful Eklutna Lake is naturally replenished from mountains that surround it each year. In addition the Lake is continuously fed by the Eklutna Glacier and Harding Ice Sheet, providing a rich natural source of Glacial water. Using less than .1% annually in its bottling operation, Clear Alaskan Glacial is a careful steward of this precious resource. We were recently given a renewed water use permit for access to our water source in perpetuity with no restrictions.

Recyclable Packaging

The Clear Alaskan Glacial commitment to the fight against global warming is reflected in the bottle and cardboard packaging, which are both 100% recyclable. Consistent with initiatives to further reduce our carbon _emissions, Clear Alaskan Glacial has also achieved a 10% reduction in PET preform waste since 2011.

Recycled Materials

All Clear Alaskan Glacial bottles utilize recycled PET1 plastic while the outer box cases are made from 50% recycle paper product.

BPA-Free

All Clear Alaskan Glacial plastic bottles are made from high grade PET-1, which is BPA-Free.
